EARLY VOTING: THERE WILL NO EARLY VOTING PERIOD FOR THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE MUNICIPAL ELECTION BECAUSE THERE IS NO OPPOSITION. TCA 2-6-102 (b)(1)

ELECTION DAY: Tuesday, June 18, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. This election is for registered voters in Ward 1 and Ward 3 in the City of Brownsville only. In order to participate in an election, a qualified voter must be properly registered no later than thirty (30) days before the election.

ACCESSIBILITY NOTICE: Disabled and/or elderly persons who believe that their polling places are inaccessible are encouraged to vote early or may vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. Voters who intend to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day must notify the commission in writing no later than June 8, 2024.

PHOTO ID LAW: Federal or Tennessee state government issued photo ID is required to vote in person, unless an exception applies. College student IDs will not be accepted. To learn more about the law and its exceptions, please call 731-772-1760 or visit, haywoodvotes.com or GoVoteTN.gov

ABSENTEE BY MAIL REQUESTS: A written request to vote Absentee by Mail in this election may be received no later than June 11, 2024. ONLINE VOTER REGISTRATION: The Tennessee Online Voter Registration System offers a convenient way for voters to easily register or change their address if they have moved. The system allows U.S. citizens with a driver’s license or photo ID issued by the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security to register to vote online.
